Fundraiser by Total Chaos (AFE student, Derek Mather's band) at Crow's Nest raised \$200 for AFE. Great community building event! New Leaf, Smog checks, Recycling and Shockley Insurance have been generating money for parent fund. Parents have begun thinking of proposals for classes/events for AFE. Bad News: Administrator's budget for 2010-2011 school year proposes a \$2.5 million cut. \$1 million from can be moved from another fund, but more will need to be cut. Proposal for 5-day furlough worth about \$1 million, and there will be further staff cuts, probably unknown until summer. Discussion on need for AFE to be proactive in regards to hiring and laying off. Parents and staff will consider writing and talking to Teacher's Union about specific needs for AFE teachers to have homeschooling or alternative ed background. We are asking Curt to be proactive with HR in this regard too.
